EMERGING LEADER MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

- Undergraduate or graduate student at Dalhousie in the Faculties of Health Professions, Medicine and Dentistry with an interest in population health
- Undergraduate or graduate student at a university or college in Atlantic Canada with an interest in population health research
- Undergraduate or graduate student working with a Scholar of HPI

EMERGING LEADER MEMBERSHIP SELECTION

- Membership eligibility and acceptance is decided by Scientific Director and Managing Director
- Potential members are assessed for eligibility based upon criteria appropriate to the membership level and their position.
- HPI reserves the right to revoke membership if deemed that a member is not appropriately contributing to the population health focus of the HPI or is not in good standing
- To be in good standing members must commit to HPI's commitment to the responsibilities as defined on page 2.

Opportunities

HPI Emerging Leaders will be given access to various supports, resources & activities:

- List status as Emerging Leader of HPI in resume and in signature line on correspondence
- Letters of support from HPI for scholarships and awards
- Access to contribute to and publish in HPI's Peer Reviewed Journal (when launched)
- Access to networking events of researchers and students across engaged in innovative, collaborative population health research and innovation
- Ability to gain skills and experiences based on the HPI Student Competency Framework for Population Health

Responsibilities

HPI Emerging Leaders are expected to:

- Recognize HPI's support on grant applications, publications and presentations; acknowledge affiliation in CVs and email signatures.
- Assist and attend at least two HPI events per year (e.g., HPI led roundtable discussions with community stakeholders, HPI Masterclass, etc.)
- Commit to assisting with the strategic vision and operations of the HPI Peer Reviewed Journal and Crossroads Health Conference
- Submit research to the HPI Peer Reviewed Journal and Crossroads Health Conference
- Provide HPI with updated CVs annually (September 1st) including granting access to a bio and photo to be used on HPI's website
- Promote HPI through social media, networking and media.

How to Apply?

HPI accepts applications 2x/year in the Fall (**October 1**) and Winter (**February 1**).

You will hear back within 4 weeks of application deadline. Your membership starts as soon as you are formally accepted.

There is a 1-2year renewable membership for HPI Emerging Leaders . You will need to reapply on annual basis by providing HPI with an updated CV annually (September 1) and highlighting evidence of contributing to the HPI mission, membership responsibilities, etc.
